Barolo Ciabot Berton 1961 DOCG

This wine has been telling the wonderful story of a territory and the three vineyards that make it up for over 50 years, offering the palate sophistication and surprising balance.

Grape variety: 100% Nebbiolo

Vineyards: in three historical vineyards in La Morra

Position: hill, with south-easterly and south-westerly exposure, at altitudes of 250-300 m above sea level.

Soil: sandy-calcareous-clay

Yield per ha: 45 hl.

Average age of vineyards: 30-35 years

Plant density/ha: 3,800 vines

Annual production: 15,000 bottles

Vinification: traditional temperature-controlled maceration in concrete tanks

Ageing: in Slavonian oak barrels and then in concrete

Alcohol content: 14 - 14.5%

Acidity: 5.4 - 5.6 g/l

Cellar life: 15 years

Description: garnet red with ruby highlights. The nose is ethereal and expansive with hints of minerals and balsamic notes accompanied by scents of rose, spices, red fruits and wax. The palate is tangy and pleasant, rich, very persistent and well supported by tannins.

Pairing suggestions: ideal with roasts, braised red meats, game and mature cheeses.
