

## Barolo Rocchettevino DOCG

A perfect balance of balsamic and mineral qualities paints the personality of Barolo Rocchettevino, an austere and refined expression of Nebbiolo.

**Grape variety:** 100% Nebbiolo

**Vineyards:** in the Rocchettevino subzone of La Morra

**Position:** hill, with south-easterly exposure, at an altitude of 400 m above sea level

**Soil:** calcareous-clay

**Yield per ha:** 40 hl.

**Average age of vineyards:** 25 years

**Plant density/ha:** 4,000 vines

**Annual production:** 4,000 bottles

**Vinification:** traditional temperature-controlled maceration in concrete tanks, with long contact of the must with skins.

**Ageing:** in Slavonian oak barrels and then in concrete

**Alcohol content:** 14 - 14.5%

**Acidity:** 5.4 - 5.6 g/l

**Cellar life:** 18 years

**Description:** brilliant garnet red colour, pleasantly spicy nose with notes of mountain herbs, balsamic nuances and slight fruity scents. The palate is clear, mineral, decidedly crisp and persistent.

**Pairing suggestions:** excellent with roasts, braised red meats, game and tasty cheeses.
